From The Desk Of Deacon Bernie - Reflection for June 04, 2024 - Ps 90: 2, 3-4, 10, 14, 16

In a general sense, the Psalms traverse the entirety of human emotions and therefore are excellent resources for prayer. We can find Psalms that express praise, gratitude, sorrow, fear and through the Psalms we can find words of hope in any of them.

Today's Psalm expresses God as our refuge. It reminds us that our life is fleeting and that our hope is in God alone. One of the lines of this Psalm that is not included in today's reading is, "You sweep men away like a dream, like grass which springs up in the morning...our guilt lies open before you, our secrets in the light of your face.'

Every time I pray these words, I am reminded that this Psalm was part of the Morning Prayer of the Church on Monday September 11th, 2001 when terrorists attacked the twin towers at the World Trade Center and the Pentagon resulting in close to 3000 dead in a matter of minutes.

We do not know the circumstances in which we will find ourselves before God Almighty. We pray, therefore, in thanksgiving for the good that he affords us, the love that He has shown us, and that He is a merciful God.

Gracious God, look upon the poverty that I bring before you today – my desire for control, my covetousness, my judgements, and angers. Soothe my broken heart that does not yet have its fill of you. Root out within me all that displeases you and fill me with Light that I may reflect you back into my family, my workplace, my place in your world. Amen.
