From the Daily Bread

The Daily Bread Outreach Program is one of St. Mary's most successful Ministries. It is located in the Cathedral's Hall at 5221 Spring Garden Road in downtown Halifax and relies on volunteers. Our goal is to serve others and to share the joy of Christian living. In all four gospels Jesus attends to the needs of the poor, and we follow his example by providing hot and cold lunches, beverages, emergency food and footwear as well as referrals to community services and art classes. From Tuesday to Friday volunteers from many different churches and groups in the Halifax Regional Municipality and beyond serve lunches to 350 to 400 guests. There are 8 teams of volunteers. They work in 2 shifts. The 4 morning teams prepare the take-out foods and refreshments and the 4 afternoon teams interact with guests, serve the meal and, as much as possible, meet their other needs. Jesus himself served the poor, healed the sick, washed the feet of his Apostles, suffered and died for all of us, rose from the dead and promised eternal life to those who believe and follow him. Why not walk in his footsteps? Why not volunteer for our Daily Bread Outreach Program? In the great commandment we are called not only to love God but to love one another. Volunteers become Christ to the poor in body and the poor in spirit, and they become Christ to us. Let us love in action not just in words. Love fulfils all the commandments.
